UPDATE: New Licensing Solution Timeline

The Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation ("IDFPR") announced an agreement for a new online licensing solution on August 6, 2024. <u>"CORE" (Comprehensive Online Regulatory Environment)</u> will feature a streamlined review process



for license applications received by IDFPR, providing a better experience for end users and greater efficiency for the Department. In addition, CORE will notify prospective licensees electronically when applications are received, reviewed, and granted.

The provider of CORE is NIC Licensing Solutions, an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Tyler Technologies. Tyler currently provides cloud-based solutions for more than 11,900 clients in all 50 states, including seven state agencies, 39 counties, and 67 local districts in Illinois.

All Departmental licensees will be transitioned to CORE in six phases over the next two years, ensuring it is fully operational for professionals and IDFPR alike. IDFPR launched CORE as part of the successful completion of Phase 1 on October 30, 2024.
